The appellants are challenging order dated 01.04.2022 passed by Hon'ble Single Judge in CRWP No. 2346 of 2022 whereby Hon'ble Single Judge has dismissed the petition for protection of their life and liberty, who have married against the wishes of respondents No. 4 to 6.

Notice of motion.

Ms. Anu Pal, Deputy Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents and submits that the State of Punjab has issued instructions dated 10.08.2010 whereby the newly wedded couple, who are facing threats from their family, can approach to the concerned Police Station and seek protection.

Keeping in view of the submissions made by learned counsel for the State, order dated 01.04.2022 is being recalled.

This appeal is being disposed of by giving direction to respondent No.2-The Senior Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar, Mohali to look into the representation dated 11.03.2022 and take necessary steps, if any required, in accordance with law, to ensure

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that the life and liberty of the appellants is not jeopardized at the hands of the private respondents.
