AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

This petition is filed seeking quashing of impugned order dated 10.3.2022 whereby non-bailable warrants of the petitioner have been issued.

The petitioner was granted regular bail. He failed to appear before the trial court twice.

After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the present petition. However, a request is made that the petitioner would surrender before the trial court on the next date and apply for regular bail, his application be taken up expeditiously.

The petition is disposed of.

In case the petitioner surrenders before the trial court on the next date and applies for regular bail, considering that there is medical ground raised for his absence, the court concerned shall take up the bail application on the same day and decide it as expeditiously as possible.
