The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioners in FIR No.20 dated 23.03.2022 registered under Sections 498-A, 406 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Sadar Budhlada, District Mansa.

By virtue of the order dated 19.04.2022 while granting interim protection, the petitioners were directed to join investigation.

It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioners that in pursuance to the order dated 19.04.2022, the petitioners have joined the investigation and fully cooperated and as such, the interim order may be made absolute.

Learned counsel for the complainant has opposed the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioners.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Najjar Singh has

endorsed the same and submitted that petitioners are no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, the order dated 19.04.2022 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C and the petition stands allowed.
