As agreed, as per statements of learned counsel for the appellant and representative of the respondent Insurance Company (separately recorded), a sum of Rs.1,30,000/- over and above the amount awarded by the Tribunal is allowed to the appellant in full and final settlement of the claim in this appeal. As per the statement of learned counsel for the appellant, the enhanced amount be paid to the appellant-Raj Kumar.

Accordingly, we **dispose** of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit a crossed-cheque amounting to Rs.1,30,000/- in the name of appellant-Raj Kumar **within a period of four weeks from today** with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court in compliance of this order, failing which, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The concerned Officer of the Lok Adalat Branch/Office shall issue proper receipt after receiving the cheque from the learned counsel/representative of the respondent Insurance Company. The appellant(s) counsel/appellant(s) may collect the cheque from the office of the Lok Adalat.

Copy of this order be supplied/sent to the counsel/parties and file be returned to the Hon'ble High Court.
