This is a third petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. read with Section 482 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR no.63 dated 11.05.2020 registered under Section 452, 323, 506 read with Section 34 IPC and Section 3(1)(x) of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989, at Police Station Cheema, District Sangrur.
