[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 26.11.2020, in CWP No.20189 of 2020 in case titled as 'M/s Parkash Chand Goyal, Contractor versus State of Punjab and others.'

[2] A perusal of order (Annexure P-1) dated 26.11.2020, reveals that CWP No.20189 of 2020, was disposed of by directing respondent No.6 to decide legal notice dated 16.10.2020 by passing a speaking order expeditiously and in any case not later than eight weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order and in case, it was found that complete payment had not been released, to release balance amount within the aforesaid period along with interest @ 6.5% per annum.

[3] Learned counsel states that pursuant to issuance of notice, the respondents have accepted the claim of the petitioner as contained in

legal notice dated 16.10.2020 and released payment to the petitioner as per his entitlement, therefore, in the circumstances, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

[4] In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
