Present petition has been filed for quashing the order dated 12.02.2019, Annexure P-1 passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Sangrur vide which the order dated 30.11.2017, Annexure P-3, passed by learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Sunam had been set aside.
