This is a first petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. to grant regular bail to the petitioner in Sections 132, 135(c), 135(1)(d) & 135 (1)(e) read with Section 135(1)(i)(D) and Sections 135(1)(i)(E) cognizable under Sections 104(4)(c) & 104(4)(d) and is non bailable under Sections 104(6) (c), 104(6)(d) and 104(6)(e) of the Customs Act, 1962.

Learned counsel for the petitioner and learned counsel appearing for Intelligence Officer Directorate of Revenue Intelligence have jointly submitted that in the present case, the petitioner has already been granted bail under Section 167(2) Cr.P.C. vide order dated 26.04.2022 passed by the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Ludhiana and thus, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.
