Status-report filed on behalf of the respondent-State, by way of the affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Barara, District Ambala, along-with Annexure R-1, is already available on the file and both these documents are taken on the record.

Learned State counsel, on the instructions from DSP Rajnish Kumar, City Thanesar, District Kurukshetra, apprises the Court that the cancellation report has already been prepared in respect of the criminal case arisen out of the FIR bearing No.912 dated 12.09.2018 registered at Police Station City Thanesar, District Kurukshetra, under Sections 415, 420 and 120-B IPC and the same would be submitted before the competent Court within four weeks.

In view of the above-discussed submission as made by learned State counsel, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition while submitting that in the eventuality of the non-submission of the cancellation report within the afore-stipulated period, the petitioner would get this petition revived by moving the appropriate application for the said purpose.
