Complaining violation of directions issued by the Court in CWP-2079-2022, titled as “Barinder Kaur Vs. State of Punjab and others”, dated 15.02.2022, the petitioner has filed the present petition under Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971. The writ petition was disposed of with the following directions:-

“The petitioner has invoked the jurisdiction of this Court in terms of Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking prayer by way of writ of mandamus for issuance of directions to the respondents to release the entire pending dues of retiral benefits alongwith interest @ 18% per annum and to decide the legal notice dated 18.10.2021, Annexure P-4.

Heard.

Notice of motion to the official respondents-State.

Ms. Simran Grewal, AAG, Punjab has put in appearance and accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents-State. Copy supplied.

Upon hearing learned counsel of both the sides and on perusal of the records, the present petition stands disposed off with the directions to the official respondents to consider the legal notice dated

18.10.2021, Annexure P-4, as representation and decide the same, moved by the petitioner, in accordance with law, by passing a speaking order preferably within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

If found entitled and if there is no impediment for the relief, the same be granted to the petitioner without any delay, as per law.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.”

Learned counsel for the respondents, on instructions submits that admittedly as per the directions, two speaking orders have been passed.

In view thereof, no further order is required to be passed.

In case the petitioner has any grievance, she shall be at liberty to revive the present petition.
