1. Prayer in the instant petition is for initiating action against the respondent for intentional and willful breach of undertaking given to this Court as recorded in order Annexure P/1 dated 24.11.2021, in CRM-M-49059-2021.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P/1 dated 24.11.2021, reveals that CRM-M-49059-2021, was disposed of by directing the respondent to consider and decide representation dated 11.05.2021, within eight weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order, after hearing all persons likely to be affected.

3. Learned counsel states that pursuant to issuance of notice, the respondent has decided representation dated 11.05.2021 and the petitioner is satisfied with the decision taken thereon, therefore, he may be permitted to permitted to withdraw the petition.

4. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of

learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
