Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in criminal case having FIR No.74 dated 26.3.2021 registered under Sections 304, 34 IPC at Police Station Division No.3, Police Commissoinerate Ludhiana.

Counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation in compliance of order dated 20.4.2022 passed by this Court. He further submits that now the matter has been compromised between the parties and copy of the compromise deed is Annexure P-2.

Counsel for the complainant has not refuted the fact of compromise and has admitted the execution of compromise deed (Annexure P-2).

State counsel on instructions from ASI Paramjit Singh has admitted the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation with the police and further submits that the petitioner is not required by the police for further investigation or custodial interrogation. State counsel has also not refuted the fact regarding compromise which has been effected between the parties.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated 20.4.2022 is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
