This is a criminal miscellaneous petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to respondents no.2 and 3 to carry on a fair and impartial investigation in FIR no.76 dated 21.05.2015 under Section 447 and Section 13-A of the Punjab Village Common Land Regulation Act, 1961 at Police Station Gharinda, District Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner at the outset has very fairly pointed out that in the present case, out of the 14 accused, 13 accused have been acquitted and one has been declared as proclaimed offender and in view of the same, the present petition has become infructuous.

Learned State counsel has verified the said fact.
