These petitions are filed seeking directions to Director General of Police, Punjab and Senior Superintendent of Punjab, Moga for fair inquiry/investigation in the complaints made by the petitioners.

Admitted facts are that during the pendency of the petitions FIR No.159 dated 20.09.2015, under Sections 302/506/120-B IPC was registered at P.S. Dharmkot, Moga against the petitioners. The matter was investigated and untraced reports were filed twice earlier. Now for the third time an untraced report is filed and matter is still pending before the Court concerned.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that during the pendency of the petitions, petitioner No.1 has expired. He further submits that though untraced report has been filed against the petitioners in the FIR but grievance of the petitioners still survives as the representation has not been decided.

Petitioners have effective remedy under the Cr.P.C. and as per the law laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in **Sakiri Vasu Vs. State of U.P.**

and Others, 2008(1) RCR (Criminal) 392 and M. Subramaniam and another
Vs. S. Janaki and another, 2020(2) AICLR 42.

Learned counsel for the petitioners seeks permission to withdraw
the present petitions with liberty to avail remedies in accordance with law.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.
