This is the first criminal writ petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for protecting the life and liberty of the petitioners and for considering the representation dated 11.03.2022. A perusal of the representation dated 11.03.2022 would show that in the same, the petitioners have stated that they have got an FIR No. 121, dated 15.11.2019 registered and the petitioners were being pressurised to withdraw the same.

Learned counsel for the State has brought to the notice of this court that with respect to the said FIR no. 121, the matter was taken up in the National Lok Adalat and on 16.07.2022, both the parties have moved a joint application for compounding the offence and the offences were compoundable and they got their statements recorded and even the quashing petition i.e. CRM-M-13067-2021 filed by respondent no. 5 and her daughter Komalpreet Kaur was dismissed as withdrawn on 25.07.2022

and after considering the said facts and also the facts that offences are compoundable, the parties were allowed to compound the offence. The order dated 13.08.2022 passed by the National Lok Adalat has been produced on record by learned State counsel, which is ordered to be taken on record as Mark-A. The same is taken on record.

No one has appeared on behalf of the petitioner.

From the abovesaid facts and circumstance, it is apparent that the parties have resolved their dispute and the present petition has thus been rendered infructuous and accordingly, disposed of as having been rendered infructuous. The petitioner is granted liberty to file a fresh petition in case any cause survives.
