Present petition has been filed under Section 482 CrPC for quashing of an FIR No.103 dated 27.06.2014 under Sections 306 IPC registered at Police Station City, Malout, Tehsil Malout District Sri Muktsar Sahib.

Notice of motion in this case was issued in this case by way of 10.09.2015.
