The instant petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for directing the respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the lives and personal liberty of the petitioners and also directing the respondents No.4 to 5 not to interfere in the personal lives and liberty of the petitioners.

Mr. Karanbir Singh, AAG, Punjab has handed over a short reply by way of affidavit of Shubeg Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police Sub Division, Fazilka on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3 wherein it is stated that the statement of the petitioners has already been recorded by the police on 11.06.2022 and in the said statement they have categorically stated that their marriage was solemnized on 27.04.2022 and that after marriage both of them are living happily and even their families are in cordial relations. There is no threat to their life and liberty from any corner and they don't need any protection. The statements of the petitioners have also been

appended along with the short reply.

In view of the same, the present petition is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous. It is made clear that in the event any grievance survives, liberty is granted to the petitioners to seek revival of the present petition.
