1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1, dated 16.11.2021, in CWP-12405-2021.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P-1, reveals that CWP-12405-2021, was disposed of vide order dated 16.11.2021, by directing the respondents to consider and decide the claim of the petitioners as made in representation dated 04.02.2021, in accordance with law, after taking into account all aspects of the matter, within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

3. Learned DAG, Haryana, refers to order Annexure R/2 dated 11.05.2022, rejecting the claim of the petitioners for re-enrolment as Home Guard Volunteer as per representation dated 04.02.2021.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioners states that in the circumstances the petitioners are not interested in pursuing the instant

petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same, with liberty to

challenge order Annexure R/2 dated 11.05.2022, by way of appropriate proceedings, in accordance with law.

5. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioners, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents, under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioners as prayed for.
