This is a petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. read with Article 226 of Constitution of India seeking directions to official respondents to act strictly in accordance with Chapter VII and Chapter XII of Code of Criminal Procedure.

It is stated that FIR No. 80 dated 13.8.2019 under Sections 420, 465, 466, 467, 471, 120 B IPC, Police Station Ramdas, District Amritsar was registered against petitioner. In the said case, petitioner after investigation was found innocent vide General Diary No. 43 dated 14.12.2021.

The grievance of petitioner is that despite that police officials are raiding his house and threatening to implicate him in a false case.

Without in any way commenting on the allegations of petitioner, this petition is disposed of with a direction to official respondents that in case, the presence of petitioner is required in connection with any inquiry, complaint or investigation, procedure as contemplated in Code of Criminal procedure be strictly followed.
