This petition is filed seeking directions to Director General of Police, Punjab Police Headquarter, Sector 9, Chandigarh and Senior Superintendent of Police, District Amritsar Rural, Punjab, not to harass and humiliate the petitioner and other family members by raiding his house.

Learned State counsel appearing on advance notice on instructions from ASI Shamsher Singh submits that the petitioner was served with notice under Section 67 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 (for short 'the Act') in FIR relating to the Act, the petitioner failed to appear in pursuance of notice, thereafter his house was raided.
