The present petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure read with Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking directions to the police not to harass and humiliate the petitioner and other family members by raiding his house.

It has been submitted by learned Deputy Advocate General, Punjab on instructions from ASI Shamsheer Singh that the petitioner was served with notice under Section 67 of the NDPS Act but the petitioner failed to appear in pursuance of the notice and that is the reason as to why his house was raided and the petitioner is not cooperating with the police.

Learned Deputy Advocate General, Punjab also submitted that a similarly situated person namely Satnam Singh had also filed a petition before this Court in CRM-M-16891-2022 and in that case also the notice

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was served on him with regard to the same offence and similar was the position in that case as well. The said petition was dismissed as withdrawn on 25.04.2022.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has stated in that view of the statement made by the learned State counsel, he may be permitted to withdraw the present petition.
