The instant writ petition has been filed seeking to challenge order dated 12.10.2017, Annexure P-9, whereby the resolution dated 30.01.2017 vide which the petitioner herein had been authorized to participate and cast his vote in the election on behalf of the Musepur Primary Agriculture Cooperative Society Limited, Musepur, District Rewari, has been rescinded, besides order dated 27.04.2020, Annexure P-10, dismissing his appeal against order dated 12.10.2017.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner would contend that as per the resolution, he was duly authorized to represent the Society, however, the said resolution was challenged on the ground of

tampering, which was at the behest of Mr. Satbir Siingh, who was neither member nor had any role to play in passing of the resolution.

At this stage, counsel appearing on behalf of the respondents would submit that the instant writ petition is not maintainable since there is a provision of filing a revision under Section 115 of the Haryana Cooperative Societies Act, 1984 and, therefore, without availing of his remedy, the instant writ petition has been filed.

Keeping in view the fact that the elections had been ordered as far back as in July 2017 and the resolution was passed to participate and cast a vote in the said election process, the instant writ petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed as such.
