At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that CWP No.13458 of 2020 was disposed of vide order dated 22.04.2022 and LPA No.438 of 2022 filed against the said decision was also dismissed vide order dated 30.05.2022 whereafter, the petitioner filed CWP No.12953 of 2022, therefore, in the circumstances, the petitioner does not press the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

2. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, no action under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 is called for against the respondent. The writ petition is disposed of accordingly with liberty to the petitioner to pursue CWP No.12953 of 2022 in accordance with law.
