Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in a case FIR No.28 dated 23.02.2022 registered under Sections 498-A, 506 IPC (Section 406 IPC added vide order dated 14.09.2022) at Police Station City Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran.

By virtue of the order dated 21.04.2022, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has joined the investigation and fully cooperated and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Dilbagh Singh, has submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, the order dated 21.04.2022 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. and the petition stands allowed.
