By way of the instant petition, the petitioners have assailed the order dated 05.01.2022 (Annexure P-8) passed by learned Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division)-cum-SDJM, Garhshankar (for short 'the Executing Court') qua the issuance of the warrant of attachment regarding their property and they have also prayed for the issuance of a direction to learned Additional District Judge, Hoshiarpur (for short 'the Appellate Court') to expeditiously decide the application (Annexure P-5), as moved by them in Civil Appeal No.427 of 2019 with a prayer to stay the operation of the judgment and decree impugned therein.

Heard.

Learned counsel for the petitioners restricts his prayer to the issuance of a direction to the Appellate Court to decide the said application within some specific time frame.

In view of the above-discussed limited prayer as made by learned counsel for the petitioners and without commenting or expressing any opinion on the merits of the afore-said application or the Civil Appeal, the revision petition in hand is hereby disposed of with a direction to the Appellate Court concerned to decide the said application (Annexure P-5) moved by the petitioners in the above-mentioned Civil Appeal, as pending before it, preferably within a period of two months from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.
