Prayer is for grant for regular bail to the petitioner in case having FIR No.232 dated 7.4.2022 registered under Sections 186, 279, 332, 336, 353, 379-A, 506, 34 IPC, Police Station Kundli, District Sonipat.

As per the allegations appearing in the FIR on 6.4.2022 complainant Sanjay working in Home Guard Department, was on his duty near Rasoi Kut. At about 6.00 pm vehicle No.DL8CAV5723 driven in rash and negligent manner came from wrong side and it was signaled to stop, however, the driver of the said vehicle did not stop

and the vehicle ran over the right foot of complainant. Only thereafter the driver of the said vehicle stopped the vehicle and started beating the complainant. In the meantime the present petitioner Deepanshu snatched mobile phone of the complainant and then the said persons fled away from the spot.

The petitioner was arrested on 7.4.2022 and is presently lodged in judicial custody.

The counsel for the petitioner submitted that the parties have effected compromise and this fact has not been denied by the counsel for the complainant.

The counsel for the parties admitted that the recovery of the mobile phone has already been effected. So no useful purpose is going to be served by keeping the petitioner behind the bars for any longer period.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case but without commenting on the merits of the case, this petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the CJM/Duty Magistrate concerned.
