Through the present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. the petitioner seeks issuance of directions that in case any criminal case is registered against him the State should give him at least 10 days notice.

At the outset, learned State counsel submits that on 19.03.2021 an FIR No.14 under Sections 376(1) and 506 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959 was registered against the petitioner at Women Police Station, Fatehabad, Haryana which, after investigation, was found to be false. Accordingly, the State filed a cancellation report before the competent Court which has also been accepted.

In the light of the afore development, no further orders are required to be passed in the present petition.
