Through the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in FIR No.62 dated 21.03.2022 registered under Sections 406 and 498-A IPC at Women Police Station, District Ludhiana.

It is the admitted position that the FIR in question originated from matrimonial disputes between the petitioner and respondent No.2 which have been settled in the Mediation & Conciliation Centre of this Court.

In view of the above, this Court is of the opinion that the petitioner's custodial interrogation is not necessary and therefore, subject to the petitioner's joining investigation as and when called by the investigating agency as also abiding by the other conditions provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C, in the event of his arrest in FIR No.62 dated 21.03.2022 registered under Sections 406 and 498-A IPC at Women Police Station, District Ludhiana, he shall be released on anticipatory bail to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer.

The petition is allowed in the above terms.
