1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 17.02.2022 in CWP No.2981 of 2022.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P-1 dated 17.02.2022 reveals that CWP No.2981 of 2022 was disposed of by directing the official respondents to consider representations dated 20.09.2021 and 12.11.2021 and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order preferably within one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order and if there was no impediment for the release of payment, to release the same to the petitioner without any delay as per law.

3. Learned counsel for the respondents has filed reply along with order Annexure R-1 dated 19.05.2022. The same is taken on record.

Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who states

of the petitioner as contained in representations dated 20.09.2021 and 12.11.2021, the petitioner may be permitted to withdraw the instant petition with liberty to challenge order Annexure R-1 dated 19.05.2022 by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.

4. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
