This is second petition that has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.96, dated 08.11.2019, registered under Sections 328, 365, 506 of IPC and Section 4 of the POCSO Act, 2012 (Sections 328, 365, 366-A IPC deleted and Sections 366, 376 IPC added lateron), at Women Police Station, Ambala.

FSL report in the case has been filed and the same is taken on record. On perusal of the same, counsel for the petitioner does not press the instant writ petition but seeks that the trial be concluded in a time bound manner.
