As per the report received from the trial Court, the case is at the stage of defence evidence and accused have examined four witnesses with next date of hearing being 14.11.2022 i.e. today.

concluded in near future, no ground is made out to grant concession of regular bail to the petitioners, during the pendency of the trial.
