1. Prayer in the instant petition is for initiating action against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 07.12.2021, in CWP-24763-2021.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P/1, reveals that CWP-24763-2021, was disposed of vide order dated 07.12.2021, by directing the respondents to consider legal notice dated 13.11.2018, as representation and decide the same in accordance with law, by passing a speaking order preferably within one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order and in case the petitioner was found entitled and there was no legal impediment for the release of payment, to release the the same to the petitioner as per law without any delay.

3. Notice has not yet been issued in this case. However, learned AAG, Punjab, has placed on record copy of order dated 21.04.2022, passed by respondent No.2, rejecting the claim of the petitioner. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who on perusal of the same, states that the petitioner is not

interested in pursuing the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same, with liberty to challenge order dated 21.04.2022, by way of appropriate proceedings, in accordance with law.

4. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
