[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-18, whereby CWP No.26005 of 2021 was disposed of vide order dated 20.12.2021 by directing the respondents to consider and decide legal notice dated 20.08.2019 in accordance with law by passing a speaking order preferably within one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order and in case of finding the petitioner entitled to relief and there being no impediment for grant of the same, to release the benefit to the petitioner without any delay.

[2] Learned Asstt. AG, Punjab, has produced copy of order dated 18.05.2022 passed by respondent No.2, rejecting the claim of the petitioner. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who states that in the circumstances, the petitioner may be permitted to withdraw the instant petition with liberty to

challenge order dated 18.05.2022 by way of appropriate proceeding in accordance with law.

[3] In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
