[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 19.07.2021 in CWP No.13038 of 2021 in case titled as Subhash Chander & another vs. State of Haryana and others.

[2] A perusal of order, Annexure P/1 reveals that CWP No. 13038 of 2021 was disposed of by directing the respondent herein to consider and decide legal notice dated 11.05.2021 qua claim of the petitioners for promotion from 09.11.2020 within two months and in case the petitioners were found entitled to the relief claimed, to give effect to the same and in case, the relief was to be declined, to pass a reasoned order and communicate the same to the petitioners.

[3] Learned DAG has produced copy of order dated 23.05.2022 granting relief to the petitioners. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioners, who on perusal of the same states that in view of the claim of petitioners having been

accepted and the petitioners promoted, the petitioners are not interested in pursuing the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

[4] In view of the position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioners, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
