The present petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No. 13, dated 07.02.2019, under Section 302 of the IPC, registered at Police Station Manimajra, U.T. Chandigarh.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, after arguing for some time, seeks permission of this Court to withdraw the present petition, at this stage.

It is prayed that since the petitioner is in custody since 02.03.2019 and 11 witnesses out of 27 have been examined and 04 have been given up and thus, 12 witnesses are left, thus, a prayer has been made that the trial court be directed to expedite the trial.

In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn, at this stage.

The trial court is requested to expedite the trial and to try and conclude the same as expeditiously as possible.

Counsel for the accused as well as counsel for the State before the trial court is directed to fully cooperate with the trial court in expeditious disposal of the trial.

Pending miscellaneous application, if any, stands disposed of in view of the abovesaid order.
