Complaining violation of directions issued by the Court in CWP-7042-2021, titled as “Raj Kumar Vs. State of Haryana and others”, dated 10.03.2022, the petitioners have filed the present petition under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971. The writ petition was disposed of with the following directions:-

“Counsel for the petitioners states that the possession of the land has still not been taken, to which learned counsel for the State has referred to the order passed by the Division Bench of this Court in CWP-PIL No.71 of 2021 titled as Court on its own motion Versus Union of India and others to contend that there was an order passed by this Court protecting dispossession of the persons, which has now been vacated on 07.03.2022 and, therefore, appropriate action will be initiated and possession taken in case there is no stay by the competent Court within a period of four weeks from today.

In the light of the statement made by the counsel for the State, we dispose of these writ petitions binding the respondents with the above statement of the counsel for the State.”

Sh. Sanjay Mittal, Additional Advocate General, Haryana, has entered appearance on behalf of the respondent and submits that as many as 21 appeals against the order passed by the Collector are pending before the Commissioner. He submits that in those appeals, an interim protection has been granted and the appeals are fixed for 11.05.2022.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the present petition is disposed of while directing the Commissioner to decide the pending appeals within the month of May, 2022.

It is hoped that after the decision of the appeal, the directions of the Court shall be complied with forthwith.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
