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**JAISHREE THAKUR, J. (Oral)**

This is a petition that has been filed seeking issuance of directions to the official respondents for conducting proper investigation in FIR No.78 dated 19.09.2017, under Sections 451, 325, 341, 323, 148, 149 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Khuian Sarwar, District Fazilka as well as for filing the report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. after conducting proper investigation in DDR No.46 dated 19.09.2017, registered at Police Station Khuian Sarwar, District Fazilka.

Counsel for the respondent-State, on instructions from ASI  
Birbal Singh, would submit that during the pendency of proceedings in this

Court, the matter has been property investigated in the FIR and the trial is carrying on whereas, after investigating the matter in DDR No.46 dated 19.09.2017, it was found that the injuries were self-inflicted and the DDR stands cancelled.

In view of the said statement given by the State counsel, counsel for the petitioner does not press the instant petition, while seeking permission to avail alternative remedies in accordance with law.

Dismissed as not pressed, with the aforesaid liberty.
