The prayer in the present petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus, directing the Regional Passport Officer (respondent No.2) to re-issue passport to the petitioner that had been applied by him on 15.06.2021.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that the cause of action in the present petition does not survive as passport bearing No.W6196601 has been issued to the petitioner on 27.10.2022. The said passport was dispatched to him on 28.10.2022 through speed post against tracking No.PP838779905IN.

Learned counsel for the petitioner acknowledges the statement of learned counsel for the respondents and submits that in view of the same, no further orders are required to be passed and the present petition be disposed of as such.

Disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
