HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI J.(Oral)

As per the allegations, 255 grams of heroin has been recovered from the petitioner, which is marginally above from the commercial quantity and the present petition has been filed seeking interim bail on medical grounds for getting the surgery done for the ailment being suffered by the petitioner.

After notice of motion, the status report has been filed by the State, wherein the ailment being suffered by the petitioner has been confirmed but it has been mentioned that the surgery can be undertaken as and when the date is fixed by the hospital concerned.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is 51 years old lady and is suffering from an ailment for which she intends to

get the surgery done from a private hospital as getting the date for the surgery from a government hospital, is a huge task.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and have gone through the record with their able assistance.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances, which have been noticed hereinabove, the petitioner has made out a case for the grant of interim bail on medical ground for getting the surgery done in respect of the ailment being suffered by her. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner will comply with all the conditions put by the concerned Magistrate/Illaqa Magistrate and the petitioner also undertakes to surrender upon expiry of the interim bail period.

Keeping in view the above, the petitioner is ordered to be released on interim bail from 09.05.2022 to 09.06.2022 subject to furnishing of requisite bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Magistrate/Illaqa Magistrate concerned. The petitioner is directed to surrender back to the jail authorities on 09.06.2022 at 05:00 pm.

As undertaken, petitioner will maintain good conduct while on interim bail.

The petition stands disposed of.
