Complaining violation of directions issued by the High Court in Civil Writ Petition No.4180-2022, titled as “Sanjay Kumar Vs. State of Haryana and others”, dated 03.03.2022, the petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.

The operative part of the order dated 03.03.2022, reads as under:-

“6. Without commenting on the merits of the case, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority to look into the grievance of the petitioner and also contentions raised in the present petition by treating the same as representation and take a decision, in accordance with law. Since application 12.02.2022 (Annexure P-12) for issuance of Sports Gradation Certificate is already pending for a considerable time, needful be done within a period of 30 days from today.

7. Until the decision on the application, the candidature of the petitioner shall not be cancelled on the ground that he has not produced the certificate. However, it is made clear that in case favourable certificate is not issued to the petitioner, respondent shall be at liberty to proceed in accordance with law without seeking leave of the Court.”

Sh. Sanjay Mittal, Additional Advocate General, Haryana, has entered appearance on behalf of the respondents and submit that needful shall be done within a period of one week, from today.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, no further order is required to be passed.

With all these observations, the present petition is disposed of.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
