Matter has been taken up through video conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.45 dated 01.04.2021, under Section 498-A of Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Division No.2, District Pathankot.

Vide order dated 28.04.2021 while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

It has been contended by the learned counsel for the petitioner and affirmed by learned counsel for the complainant that the matter is finally settled in the Mediation Centre at District Courts Pathankot and the parties have filed the petition under Section 13-B of Hindu Marriage Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to order dated 28.04.2021, petitioner has joined the investigation and as such his interim bail may be made absolute.

Learned State counsel, on instructions, affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, interim order dated 28.04.2021 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.
