The challenge is to correctness of the order passed by the trial Court striking off the defence of the petitioner (the defendant) in a suit for specific performance of the agreement to sell. On reading of the order, it is evident that the petitioner has failed to file the written statement despite the repeated opportunities. Even the Court has imposed costs.

The learned counsel representing the petitioner submits that the case is now fixed for hearing on 14.12.2022, but no further proceedings have taken place. He submits that he will file the written statement with an advance copy to the learned counsel representing the plaintiff before the next date fixed by the trial Court in the suit.

The dispute is with regard to the immovable property. The petitioner is the only defendant in the suit.

Hence, let the petitioner file written statement within 15 days, from today, subject to the payment of cost of Rs.5,000/- to the plaintiff.

With all these observations, the revision petition is disposed of.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
