Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C., seeking quashing of FIR No.181 dated 21.09.2014 registered under Sections 354, 354-A, 354-D and 452 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station City Roopnagar, District Roopnagar (Annexure P-1) and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of mutual agreement (Annexure P-2).
