The instant petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus for directing the respondents No.1 to 6 to take appropriate legal action against respondents No. 7 and 8 who forcibly recovered the Truck/vehicle of the petitioner bearing registration No. MH 43 Y 1889.
