1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating action against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 07.01.2022, in CWP-123-2022.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P-1, dated 07.01.2022, reveals that CWP-123-2022, was disposed of by directing that the enquiry initiated against respondent No. 5 be concluded expeditiously.

3. At this stage, learned Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, states that the Enquiry Officer has submitted report on 07.05.2022 whereafter the competent authority has issued notice to the delinquent on 09.05.2022 to show cause against the findings recorded in the inquiry report as also as to why recovery be not made from him. Reply is also stated to have been furnished by the delinquent in response to the show cause notice. Learned DAG states that the competent authority i.e. Respondent No.3, shall pass final orders on the same expeditiously.

4. In the light of the position noted above, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any orders against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 while directing respondent No. 3 to take a

final decision on the reply to the show cause notice and pass orders in

respect thereto in accordance with law, preferably within two weeks from today.
