In the present petition the grievance is that the petitioner is entitled to be engaged and appointed as a guest faculty in the subject of Electronic and Communication Engineering in the respondent No.3 Polytechnic Education Society, Sampla, District Rohtak. In support of the prayer, the petitioner has made the averments that the teaching workload exist in the said institute and therefore, the petitioner is entitled for the adjustment as guest faculty in the said institute. Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that the petitioner has already raised the said grievance in the legal notice dated 05.04.2022 (Annexure P-9) and the petitioner will be satisfied and the interest of justice will be served in case, the respondent No.2 is directed to decide the same by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Ms. Anju Sharma Kaushik, DAG, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State and raises no objection in deciding the legal notice (Annexure P/9) in a time bound

manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

In view of the request made, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioner in legal notice (Annexure P/9), respondent No.2 is directed to decide the legal notice (Annexure P/9) by passing a speaking order within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order.

Present writ petition stands disposed of.
