[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the
respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-7,
dated 28.02.2022, in CWP No.3854 of 2022.

[2] Reply along with Annexures (R-1 to R-5) has been filed by
the respondent appearing-in-person. Reference is made to order dated
29.03.2022 (Annexure R-1) and Annexure R-2 dated 25.05.2022 deciding
representation and legal notice dated 03.01.2022 and 28.01.2022 in
compliance of order Annexure P-7, dated 28.02.2022,. The same is taken
on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner,
who on perusal thereof states that in the circumstances, he does not press
the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same with

liberty to challenge order (Annexures R-1 and R-2) dated 29.03.2022 and 25.05.2022 by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.

[3] In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
