Complaining violation of order passed on 22.12.2021 in Civil Writ Petition No.26360 of 2021, titled as “Brij Lal Vs. State of Punjab and another”, the petitioner has filed the present petition with a prayer to initiate proceedings under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.

The operative part of the order dated 22.12.2021, reads as under:-

“Upon hearing learned counsel for both the sides and on perusal of the records, the present petition stands disposed off with direction to the official respondents, especially respondent No.2, to consider the representation dated 05.03.2021 (Annexure P6) and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order preferably within a period of one month from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

If found entitled and if there is no impediment for the release of payment, the same be granted to the petitioner without any delay, as per law.”

The petitioner submits that despite directions, respondent No.1 namely Director Public Instructions (Secondary Education), Punjab, has failed to decide the representation.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, it is considered appropriate to grant one more opportunity to the Director Public Instructions (Secondary Education), Punjab.

Let a copy of the order be sent by the petitioner to the Director Public Instructions (Secondary Education), Punjab, by the registered post acknowledgment due within a period of 10 days.

It is hoped that the Director Public Instructions (Secondary Education), Punjab, will comply with the order, failing which the petitioner shall have liberty to file an application for revival, if the order is not complied with.

With all these observations, the present petition is disposed of.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
