Matter has been taken up through video conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioners in FIR No.18 dated 20.2.2021 registered under Section 498-A IPC at Police Station, Mehtiana, District Hoshiarpur.

By virtue of the order dated 3.9.2021 while granting interim protection the petitioners were directed to join investigation.

It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioners that in pursuance to the order dated 3.9.2021, the petitioners have joined the investigation and fully cooperated and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute.

Learned counsel for the complainant opposes the submissions made by counsel for the petitioners.

Learned State counsel has endorsed the fact that petitioners have joined investigation and submitted that petitioners are no more
