VIKAS BAHL, J.(ORAL)

This is a first petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in complaint case bearing NCB Crime no.20/2017 dated 29.03.2017 registered under Sections 8, 18, 21, 23, 29, 60 and 61 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances, Act, 1985 (in short "NDPS Act") at Police Station NCB, Amritsar, District Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner be permitted to withdraw the petition, at this stage but has prayed that since the petitioner has been in custody since long, thus, the trial Court be directed to decide the case as expeditiously as possible.

In view of the statement given by learned counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn, at this stage.

The trial Court is requested to expedite the trial and conclude the same as expeditiously as possible. The petitioner and the State would assist the Court in expeditious disposal of the case.
